### **Qualifications for Becoming a Member Of NJHS:**

Ecker Hill International School follows the guidelines recommended by the National Organization. To be a member of this organization is an honor and a responsibility taken very seriously by this school.

- 1. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.7 or higher.**
- 2. Applicant must prove that they have high standards in the following:**
  - a. leadership:** involved in school activities, has above average problem solving skills, offers a positive influence on peers, keeps a positive helpful attitude, is responsible, reliable and dependable
  - b. character:** takes criticism well and accepts recommendations graciously, has exceptional behavior (cheerful, friendly, stable, honest, respectful), upholds principles of morality and ethics, observes rules, punctuality, and faithfulness both inside and outside the classroom.
  - c. citizenship:** understands the importance of civic involvement, has a high regard for freedom, justice, and respect of the American form of government, demonstrates mature participation and responsibility through involvement with activities such as scouts, community organizations, or clubs.
  - d. service:** upholds scholarship and maintains a loyal school attitude, involvement in outside activities (church, sports, scouts, volunteer services, family duties), willing to sacrifice to offer assistance to others, does committee and group work without complaining, shows courtesy by assisting visitors, classmates, teachers, and any other person.
- 3. Referrals to ISS, suspensions or “Three Strikes” will be taken into consideration.**
- 4. Applicant must have a completed application turned in to the office by February 8th. NO exceptions will be made.**
