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AFTER SCHOOL HOMEWORK CLUB BUSING EXPECTATIONS 2016/17

1. **RIDING THE SCHOOL BUS IS A PRIVILEGE.** Only those who are eligible (6th graders 1.5 miles and 7th graders 2.0 miles or further from school) and have submitted this signed document and agree to follow bus rider expectations will be authorized to ride the assigned After School Program bus. The same expectations that are in place on the school buses that bring students to school and take them home will be in place.

2. **TO MAINTAIN YOUR SCHOOL BUS RIDING PRIVILEGE :**
 - a. Follow the instructions of your bus driver
 - b. Scan your bus pass getting on and off the bus,
 - c. Sit in your seat with good manners for the entire ride,
 - d. The driver is authorized to assign seats.
 - e. Get off at the correct bus stop,
 - f. Talk with quiet inside voices,
 - g. Keep your hands to yourselves,
 - h. Follow the school bus rules (see district website www.pcschools.us)
 - i. Laptop computers may be used on silent mode, and used only by you. The same with cell phones.
 - i. Only one ear bud for head phones may be used so you can hear instructions from the driver.
 - j. The driver is authorized to have you turn computers, cell phones, or other wireless devices off, or other distraction/disturbance items and may even place them in a safe place for you while riding the school bus.

3. **IF STUDENT BEHAVIOR AND/OR NOISE LEVELS BECOME A DISTRACTION,** it creates a very unsafe situation for everyone on and around the school bus. Distracting the driver is the greatest danger in transporting students safely, and is a very serious and unsafe situation.
 - a. The driver may pull the bus over to the side of the road and stop to restore order before continuing to drive.
 - b. If necessary, a Student Conduct Report may be submitted to the Transportation Department and forwarded to EHMS administration for possible disciplinary action.
 - c. Student Conduct Reports are kept on file.

4. **IF YOU FAIL TO FOLLOW THESE PROCEDURES THE FOLLOWING MAY TAKE PLACE :**
 - a. You may receive a verbal warning,
 - b. **You may lose the school bus riding privilege for the After School bus for the remainder of the school year.**
 - i. This can take place with the first incident. It may also affect the privilege of riding your regular bus and activity/field trip buses.
 - c. If you damage the bus, you will have to pay for it.
 - d. Your parents will be responsible for your way to school.

5. **OBEYING AND FOLLOWING THE SCHOOL BUS RULES**, you and everyone else will have a safe ride, and maintain the privilege of riding the school bus. These are posted on the bus for everyone to see and remember.
